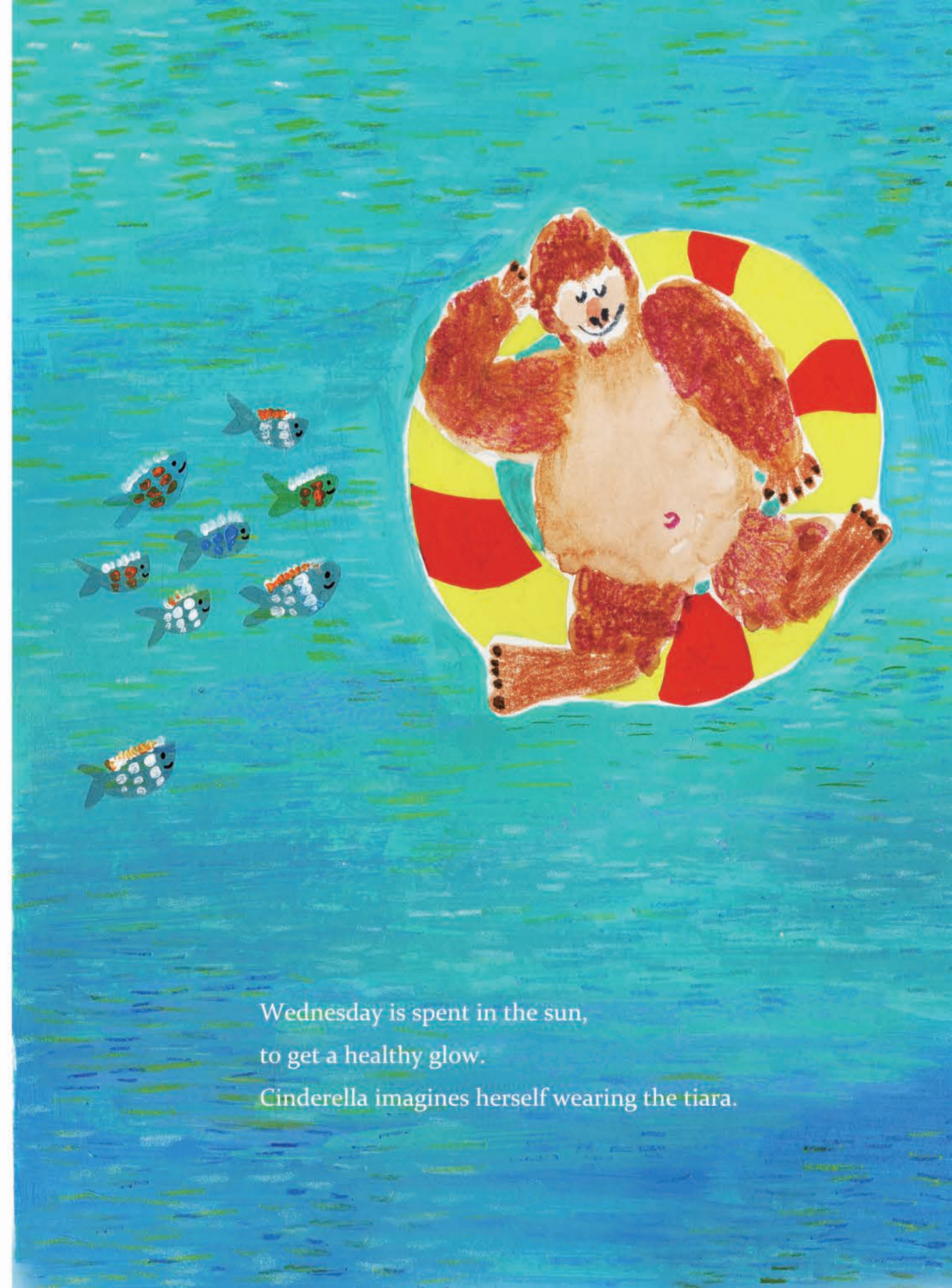
At Monday's yoga class,
